

Code of Conduct for Volunteers

Mazenod College holds the care, safety and well-being of students as a central and fundamental responsibility of our organisation. Students have a right to be safe, and we commit to ensure and protect these rights in all aspects of our community and programs.

The College expects all school community members including staff, volunteers, coaches, tutors, students, parents and visitors to share this commitment.

Mazenod has a mandatory policy relating to child protection and is committed to providing a child safe environment which safeguards all students. As volunteers, we require that you understand your responsibilities and undertake to provide a safe and secure environment for the students, and to do your utmost to ensure that the student is not exposed to harm.

To assist us provide a safe environment and a positive educational climate, volunteers are expected to comply with the following College **Conduct Statements**:

- You act safely and competently.
- You give priority to students' safety and well-being in all your behaviour and decision making.
- You listen and respond to the views and concerns of students, particularly if they communicate (verbally or non-verbally) that they do not feel safe or well. Report any concerns to a teaching staff member.
- You conduct yourself in accordance with laws, agreements, policies and standards relevant to your relationship with the school community.
- You respect the dignity, culture, values and beliefs of each member of the school community.
- You treat personal information about members of the school community as private and confidential.
- You promote and preserve the trust and privilege inherent in your relationship with all members of the school community.
- You maintain and build on the community's trust and confidence in the College.
- You act reflectively and ethically.
- You communicate appropriately when engaging with students, staff and other members of the College.
