# GIFTED & TALENTED



This is the College's most prestigious music scholarship program offered to our most dedicated and determined music students. Students selected will not necessarily have had previous music experience, but they must demonstrate a willingness to learn and have a strong commitment to practice.

This is a two-year scholarship, beginning as a bursary in Year 8 followed with a full scholarship in Year 9. The students are provided with an instrument, group tuition and a structured music program with group performance opportunities.

#### **GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS**

Gifted and talented students are identified early in Year 7 and given support to develop their intellectual aptitudes.

The Gifted and Talented Coordinator works with students to engage them in a range of co-curricular activities to work with likeminded peers to compete against students from other schools. These competitions will include the Da Vinci Decathlon and Philosothon. Other opportunities include the RIOT program in research and innovation and the Explore Science program, that takes our boys deep into the wonder of science.

### **PARTNERSHIPS**

Great opportunities exist for student involvement through WAFL, Swan Districts Football Club and Basketball.

In the senior years students have access to partnerships that connect them to tertiary

The site for Mazenod College was cleared in May 1965 and the foundation stones laid four months later, our first College building was finished in May 1966.

On February 14, 1966 Fr McCarthy and Fr Mackintosh welcomed thirty-one boys as first Grade 6 and 7 students, establishing Catholic Education for boys in the Perth Hills.

Shortly after this Fr Don Hughes was appointed as the first Rector and Mazenod College was officially opened on May 8 1966.

Our Oblate dream to serve the people of Western Australia through education was fully realised with the establishment of a Boarding residence in 1967, enabling students from rural areas to benefit from a quality education in a Catholic and Oblate tradition.

Our College is one of three founded by the Oblates in Australia, sharing a common vision and mission with Mazenod College, Victoria and Iona College, Queensland. In more recent years St. Eugene's College, Queensland, was founded within a parish operated by the Oblates and so the message and traditions of St Eugene De Mazenod continue to grow.

We have an active and supportive Mazenod Old Boys Association, so your son's Mazenod journey continues long after he leaves the College.

Two ovals, a gymnasium, swimming pool, tennis, basketball and handball courts provide a great outlet for sport and physical activity. The new Provence, Design and Technology Centre which opened in 2018, is state of the art, providing tailored learning in design, materials technologies, engineering and vocational training.
