- Covid19 Hardship Fund – Andrew asked how much was going to be in the fund and by what criteria was it to be issued. \$10,000 shared between 4/5 families was agreed upon. A meeting is to be scheduled with Eric and 1 or 2 committee members to discuss the necessary criteria required to be a recipient of the fund in 2021.
- Sports club first aid kits being kept up-to-date – Andrew spoke to Chris M who is contacting the College sports clubs to determine their auditing process regarding first aid kits.
