Significant change around what happens if homework is not done. Homework benefits learning – research supports it at highschool level. Homework should connect to learning in the classroom. For fifteen years – homework detention room. Reason for students doing homework was to avoid punishment. There needs to be a strategy to promote what homework is really about. Principle of homework is to be connected to learning e.g. practice, pre-reading, reinforcing positive learning habits. Resist giving a time for each subject area. Student records h/w, completes it or provides a note from parents. Teacher – sets achievable h/w, ensures it connects to learning in class, records non-completion and the consequence is to talk to the student. Parent – culture high expectations, be resilient, self-advocacy, support son to be accountable for learning, Head of Year – model effective learning, communicate with families if student is not doing h/w. Leadership of learning area. Getting rid of homework detention room. Yellow page being removed from student diary. Record in SEQTA in pastoral care notes. When Head Of Year see a pattern, they are to research what's underpinning that avoidance? Strategies for h/w support, support positive view of h/w rather than a negative view.

Y7-8 40-90 mins, Y9-10 60-120 mins

Y11-12 1-3 hours.

• Feedback from parents – communication through SEQTA – very good, results and tests need to be recorded on time – great when teachers are uploading information as parents can plan family around. Pastoral part – alerts. Delivery and alerts good – all been coming through. Always put a comment in - staff. Preparatory homework? Science very good. Immediate response back from teachers. Alert for HOY/subject co-ordinator to know if results have not been returned/teacher is swamped. Touch base with classroom teacher/Head of

Learning Area. Approximately two-week turn around. Purchase enhancements? – SEQTA analyse – not that great. Grad point average and do a comparison. Which student has the greatest drop – analyse e.g. medical issue, attendance alerts. Sessions with parents on how to navigate it? Version for parents that does not compromise privacy. Homework club – in support of the policy? Being trialled. Quiet room. Library open until 4pm. Go into OneNote for additional – use of diary will remain.
