REGISTRATIONS ARE NOW OPEN FOR THE 2018/19 CRICKET SEASON

This is a fantastic opportunity for your son/daughter to play Australia's premier summer sport in an enjoyable environment. The cricket season runs from October through to March although individual programs may vary in their duration.

We are excited to offer the following programs for the 2018/19 season:

JUNIOR BLASTERS Ages 5-7 | 60 mins | \$99

Junior Blasters is for kids learning the basic skills of cricket with participants building their skills through fun, game based activities. The games are designed for small groups to ensure that every child gets a go, allowing them to test and learn new skills. When they have mastered the basics they will be ready to graduate to Master Blasters where they can play modified games of cricket. All equipment is provided and parents can join in the fun. Fees are inclusive of a Junior Blasters pack (includes a t-shirt with your child's name on it and bucket hat in your choice of Big Bash team colour, bat & ball, personalised bat sticker sheet & progression tracker.)

MASTER BLASTERS Ages 7-10 | 90 mins | \$99

Master Blasters is a fun, social, safe cricket program for boys and girls who can bowl with a straight arm over 14m. It is much shorter than traditional cricket, with a maximum of 90 minutes playing time. All the equipment is supplied and the games usually take place at the same venue each week. The modified format ensures that everyone gets a chance to bat, bowl and field. Fees are inclusive of a Master Blasters pack (includes LMJCC club playing shirt, Big Bash player cap in your choice of Big Bash team colour & progression tracker.)

ALL-GIRLS CRICKET Ages 11-17 | 2 hrs | \$170 (family discount available)

Perth Scorchers Girls League is a fun, fast and competitive cricket league specifically organised for girls of all abilities and skill levels. Games are played in a T20 format of 2 hours duration. The league currently has U/13, U/15 and U/18 divisions and we are hoping to enter our first LMJCC team/s this season.

JUNIOR COMPETITION Ages 9-17 | up to 4 hrs | \$170 (family discount available)

Traditional games of cricket within the South East Metropolitan Junior Cricket Council (SEMJCC) for boys and girls with basic cricket skills aged from 9 years (or Year 3) onwards. U/11, U/13 and U/14 Grades play on Saturday mornings, with U/10, U/12, U/15 and U/17 Grades playing on Sunday mornings. All age groups take part in a home and away season. Finals and combined 2-day and T20 competitions apply from U/13 onwards.

Which Junior Competition Grade should my child play in?

- Your child plays in the grade detailed below depending on the age your child is as of 30thJune 2018.
- Dispensation may be given for a player to play out of their age group subject to club and association approval and if vacancies exist after all players of the correct age have been placed. A player cannot play in a grade more than 2 years above their age. Please note that if we receive insufficient registrations to field a team in a particular age group, combined age teams may be formed (i.e. 10 & 11 year olds may be placed together in an U/12 team).
- Boys: Dispensation will not be given for older players to play in a lower grade.
- Girls: Dispensation may be given for older players to play up to 2 years longer in each age group dependent upon ability (i.e. U/13 girls may play in the U/11 competition)

UNIFORMS

Alternatively, you may complete and return a uniform order form, along with your payment, as per the instructions on the form. Please note that we are unable to accept credit card payments for uniform purchases. *Junior Blasters and Master Blasters are not required to purchase a uniform as shirts and hats are included within their fees.*

LMJCC is run entirely by parent volunteers, so if you are able to coach, score, umpire, manage the players or join our committee, it is most appreciated.
