REGISTRATIONS ARE NOW OPEN FOR THE 2017/18 CRICKET SEASON

This is a fantastic opportunity for your son/daughter to play Australia's premier summer sport in an enjoyable environment (Mazenod students who register to play for the Club will be eligible to participate in Mazenod College representative teams such as the Oblate Cup Team). The season commences in October with fixtures yet to be finalised. Details on registration fees are provided in the attached registration form.

We appreciate your prompt registration as planning is well underway for the coming season. Players registered before 31st August 2017 will be given priority and we will do our best to accommodate requests where possible. Late registrations are not guaranteed a place in a team and may have to wait until a vacancy occurs (with no guarantee of playing with friends). Please note that the Club will only recognise a player as being registered once fees have been paid.

HOW TO REGISTER

In2Cricket participants MUST register online. Junior competition players (U/10-U/17) may register via one of the following methods:

- Register online at playcricket.com.au and pay by credit card (NB family discount is not available online). To register correctly please enter your child's MyCricket ID. If you do not know your child's ID please contact registrar.lmjcc@hotmail.com. For children new to cricket, a MyCricket ID will be created when you register.

Which Grade should my child play in the 2017/18 Season?

- Your child plays in the grade detailed below depending on the age your child is as of 30thJune 2017.
- Dispensation may be given for a player to play out of their age group subject to club and association approval and if vacancies exist after all players of the correct age have been placed. A player cannot play in a grade more than 2 years above their age. Please note that if we receive insufficient registrations to field a team in a particular age group, combined age teams may be formed (i.e. 10 & 11 year olds may be placed together in an U12s team).
- Boys: Dispensation will not be given for older players to play in a lower grade.
- Girls: Dispensation will be given for older players to play up to 2 years longer in each age group if desired (i.e. U13 girls may play in the U11 competition)
