GENERAL INFORMATION

OFFICE HOURS

The College office is open between 8am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

LIBRARY HOURS

The Library is open between 7.30am and 4pm Monday to Friday. It is closed at recess but open at lunch.

SUPERVISION

Parents please note that supervision at the College is between 8.10am and 3.50pm. We would prefer students were NOT on the grounds outside of these hours as there is no supervision.

For safety reasons students arriving before 8.10am and still on the grounds after 3.50pm are NOT to play any unorganized sporting activities and are to stay in the quadrangle area.

UNIFORM

All boys must wear the complete, correct College uniform traveling to and from school and at all College functions. This applies to all uniforms.

SUMMER UNIFORM

White College shirt with crest and College Tie – Year 7-11

Grey shorts with grey or black belt

Black leather College lace up shoes – (no slip-ons, desert boots/boots or sneaker type shoes). **Shoes must be polished.**

College socks

1st and 4th Term only: Grey shorts or trousers, grey or black belt with plain buckle.

Mazenod College bags (backpack and carry bag) can be purchased from the College Uniform Shop. These are compulsory for all students. Sports bags are also available.

Swimming will require blue College shorts with 'M' insignia, Mazenod blue swim trunks or black Speedos.

SICKNESS

If a student is sick before leaving for school, parents are asked to consider whether it is reasonable to allow the young man to come to school. Parents' common sense is appealed to here, it is not good to 'give in' to every illness but at the same time too many students are sent to school because there is no one at home.

If a student should become ill during the school day, he must report to the Office, having first obtained a pass from his classroom teacher. If it is necessary parents will be notified to come and collect their son.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HOMEWORK

Homework is given to reinforce the daily classroom learning. Homework is not restricted to writing assignments. Review, preparation for exams, further reading, investigation of topics beyond the basic requirements of the course, constitute areas of study. A guide of the amount of study that should be done by each year group is given in the College diary.

Parents should closely monitor the homework diary.

SPORT

The College is a member of the ACC (Associated and Catholic Colleges) as well as fielding teams in various district sporting competitions. These competitions take place mid-week, evenings and weekends. All students attending the College MUST, as part of their College obligations, be available if required to represent the College in Sporting fixtures.

MISSED LESSONS AND NON-ATTENDANCE OF MUSIC LESSONS

Whilst it is acknowledged that class assessments take priority, if a student is unable to attend his lesson in the event of a test/excursion he must inform Performing Arts Staff at least 24hrs in advance to allow adequate time for lesson rescheduling. If a student is going to be absent from school on the day of his lesson, to avoid the lesson fee being charged, please notify Mrs Greenley of the absence before 7.30am on 9291 1535 as well as notifying College Administration. Parents will be informed by email every time their son misses a lesson without reason and the lesson charge will be incurred.

PARENT-SCHOOL RELATIONSHIP

It is understood that parents send their sons to Mazenod College because they support the College's policy as expressed in its rules and regulations. However, in the endeavours of the Staff to provide a full Christian education at Mazenod, they are only supplementing what is primarily the responsibility of the parents. Parents are encouraged to take an active interest in College activities, and to cooperate with the College authorities in all matters. The Parents & Friends Association meets regularly and gives invaluable assistance to all aspects of College life. College-Parent relationship can only be to the benefit of your sons and our students.
